Intaglio Editions

Use a Photogravure Template File from Intaglio Editions to prepare your photographic or graphical image files for custom polymer photogravure plate services. This procedure assumes the printmaker has a working knowledge of their computer and Adobe Photoshop or similar image editing program.

- 1. Open and save a new copy of your image file in Photoshop.
- 2. Open the desired size template file.
- 3. Choose your image file and click on >Image>Image Size.
- 4. In this window, make sure "Resample" is checked.
- 5. Set the resolution to 360 Pixels per Inch
- 6. Now, in this same window, set your desired image size and ensure it is smaller than the plate dimensions in your template.
- 7. Flatten your image file and copy it to the clipboard
- 8. Now choose the template file.
- 9. From the top menu choose >Windows>Layers and click the eyeball next to "DELETE THIS LAYER". This will remove our logo from the background.
- 10. Choose >Edit>Paste Special>Paste In Place. This makes sure your image file will be pasted in the exact center of the template. If a "Source Space" warning comes up, click "Convert." If your image appears larger or smaller than you expected, ensure you completed steps 1-6 properly.
- 11. Flatten your template file and Save As a TIFF.
- 12. When the TIFF file options window comes up, select "No Compression" and complete the save operation.
- 13. Repeat the above steps until all your files have been saved. If you wish to combine multiple smaller images into one template, please ensure you leave 1/2 inch between images. Additional cutting fees will apply.
- 14. Login to your account at https://shop.IntaglioEditions.com to upload each of your image files or place new orders.
